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a. STATE YOUR SIGNIFICANT DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Commander, USA MEDDAC, consisting of 78-bed hospital, 3 Troop Medical clinics, 3 Satellite Health Clinics, 5 Chemical Depot Health Clinics, and Installation Public Health Department, with staff of over 450 active duty, 700 civilians, 100 contractors and 150 volunteers, serving a population of over 130,000 beneficiaries. Manage an operating budget of over \$70 million dollars. Coordinate with DoD Lead Agent, local civilian hospitals, command counterparts at Air Force installations and Great Plains Regional Medical Command for implementation of TRICARE and TRICARE Plus in the region. Coordinate with the Combat Support Hospital, medical units of the supported commands and reserve component to provide medical treatment, readiness training, and medical proficiency training. Support medical SRP and mobilization activities as part of post power projection mission.

b. INDICATE YOUR MAJOR PERFORMANCE OBJECTIVES

**Routine:**

- Support 7ID and Fort Carson Soldiers in mobilization/demobilization medical requirements.
- Coordinate garrison health support as Director of Health Services for Fort Carson, Colorado.
- Maintain continuous JCAHO readiness for the MTF and outlying clinics.
- Provide supervision and resources to our 5 chemical depots in support of the Army Chemical and Biological Surety Program.
- Support Federal Response Plan by performing National Disaster Medical System in Colorado.

**Problem Solving:**

- Integrate AFA , Peterson AFB and EACH into a joint medical program, responsive to the needs of the Colorado Springs Military Community.
- Posture EACH to a successful integration into the next generation of TRICARE contracts.
- Obtain funding for several critical projects necessary for optimal patient care, to include OB/Womens Health Initiatives, acquisition of MRI, and facilities upgrades.
