Welcome to the Evan's Army Community Hospital's phlebotomy room, part of the Department of Pathology. Our mission is to implement an integrated laboratory support system that ensures accurate and timely laboratory results in support of our active duty military, Family members and retirees.

We operate from 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. We see approximately 5,500 to 6,300 patients on a monthly basis. Our average wait time is four minutes per patient and 97 percent of our patients are seen within 15 minutes. Our busiest times of the day are Monday through Thursday from 7 a.m. to noon.

It is our goal to maintain a clean, safe and caring environment to each and every customer who comes through our department. Our phlebotomists work very hard to ensure that all of our customers receive the best care available, their needs are met, and they get through in a timely manner.
